ITU/NIA International ICT Volunteers Programme 2016

The "ITU-NIA International IT Volunteers (IIV) Program 2016" was co-ordinated by TRCSL in collaboration with the International Telecommunications Union and National Information Agency (NIA) of Korea with the intention of enhancing the ICT knowledge and skills of persons with special needs in Sri Lanka.

This year, three volunteer teams comprised of twelve Korean undergraduates arrived in Sri Lanka on 7th July 2016 to conduct ICT training programmes at three education centers during the months of July & August in 2016. Under the e-NABLE project, the arrangements are made by TRCSL for these volunteer teams to train students with special education needs & teachers involved in special education at Sevana Special School-Pita Kotte, Vocational Training Center-Wattegma and Kothalawalapura Maha Vidyalaya, Ratmalana.

The Korean IT Volunteer (KIV) programme is hosted by the Ministry of Science, ICT & Future Planning of Korea and managed by the National Information Society Agency of Korea (NIA) since 2001. Every year the Government of South Korea sends teams of Korean volunteers skilled in Information Technology (IT) to developing countries. Unlike any other country, the "International ICT Volunteers Programme" has been used by us with a view of uplifting special education in Sri Lanka.

The members of the "T.I.K" team are Mr. Dongheon KWAK (Team Leader), Mr. Hyunkyu LEE, Mr. Sunghee YANG and Mr. Minsoo KIM and they will be conducting their ICT training programme for teachers at Kothalawalapura Maha Vidyalaya, Ratmalana.
